**Nov 1<sup>st</sup> thru Dec 31<sup>st</sup> you must pay for your exam \$205.00 and complete it by Midnight 12/31/2020.** If an exception is granted for any reason, there will be a late fee of \$75.00.

After January 10<sup>th</sup> you will need to contact Selena ([selenam@fedseminars.com](mailto:selenam@fedseminars.com)) to see what the next steps will be.

We have started using Thryv to send out invoices. This way you may pay online vs. sending us your card information. Once your invoice is paid you will receive the link and updates.

**Test Link:**

You have 2 attempts to complete the exam on the link, no need to contact us for a new one. If you do not pass the exam with the two attempts, please email Erin ([erin@fedseminars.com](mailto:erin@fedseminars.com)) to be reset. **You are required to test and pass with a 75% or higher.**

If you have any questions, we ask that you **email** us and give a time that it is convenient to contact you. This will prevent the possibility of the phone tag scenario and missed messages.
